Great news! The Florida District is working hard to bring you a new and improved OPR system that will better enhance your experience with Pride Report and Officer Information Form submissions. With the changes coming soon we will be locking the current Pride Report function and clubs will not be able to submit or update them in the current system. **The new system will be up and running in early June and at that point clubs should submit their March, April, and May Pride Reports into the new system by June 15th. If clubs have already submitted these reports you will need to resubmit them when the new system goes live.** As long as all reports are submitted into the new system by June 15th then there will be no late penalty.

We are sorry for the inconvenience this may cause, but we are confident you will find the new system more user friendly.

Please note: you can still update and submit your Officer Information Forms using the current system. We will be able to transfer that data over to our new system.
