5. Have your club's work acknowledged in the District.
6. Give other clubs ideas for projects.
7. Qualify the club and officers for several awards at District and International competitions.
8. Let your Lt. Governor and others know if you need help.
9. Share with your Kiwanis club, your principal, and others what you have accomplished.
10. Help evaluate how effective the Lt. Governor is in assisting their clubs.
11. Gives the District Secretary something to do.
12. Keep your Lt. Governor from bugging you about doing them.

It's almost Christmas and I have a suggestion as a service project for each club. Organize a Christmas hamper for a certain place e.g. Maples, Humane Society, Pines etc. Each member should provide a gift with it wrapped saying if it's for female/male, age range etc. If you are interested please tell me which place your club will send a hamper to avoid 2 clubs sending it to the same place.
