## Club Bylaws

This year we have a new "Standard Form for Key Club Bylaws" that the Legal, Elections, and Credentials Committee has created.

It is important that all clubs in the Florida District are operating under the updated bylaws.

Here are the steps on how bylaws are adopted:

- 1) The bylaws must be voted on and receive at least 2/3 majority of the club body (i.e. dues-paying members) at a regular meeting.
- 2)The bylaws then need to be sent to the high school principal, the sponsoring Kiwanis club, and Key Club International (Please send two signed copies to Key Club International. One copy will be signed by Key Club International Administrator and returned to the club).
- 3)Once all these conditions are met, the bylaws take effect.

It is particularly important that all clubs update their bylaws this year.
