## ST. IGNATIUS

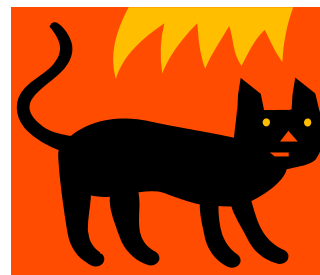
They have increased their membership by...let's just say A LOT! They still need to turn in their pride report so I know what they've done still!!!!
