





Club Dues <

Club Dues are an important part of being a Key Club. It officially registers your club in the Key Club International Roster. Below are a few goals for our Division concerning Dues.

- Turn all dues in by October the 1st the latest, to ensure that every club gets The Early Bird Patch
- Dues are \$15, (pay \$5 every week until you reach the \$15)
- Treasurers please enforce the deadline of October 1st



YOF

The Youth Opportunity
Fund (YOF) is Key Club
International's grant program for Service projects.
You can receive funding
for projects between \$100\$2000 once a year. Divisional projects do not receive this.

FLOF

The Florida Opportunity
Fund (FLOF) is a grant for
service projects available
only in the Florida District of
Key Club International.
FLOF can give clubs up to
2/3 the money necessary for
service projects; however,
schools must provide the
rest. You can receive ranges from \$100 to \$1,000.

The Endowment Fund

- What is the Endowment Fund? It is a fund that helps to lower the cost of DCON as well as provide Key Club Scholarships to seniors.
- What is the Endowment Goal? We have a five -year plan to put 1 million dollars in the Endowment Fund.
