Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF



The Florida District of Key Club International's goal to raise US\$66,818.26 for The Eliminate Project we made 5 years ago. The Eliminate Project's focus is to eliminate maternal and neonatal tetanus (MNT), a disease that is contracted during childbirth due to an unvaccinated mother being exposed to unsterile instruments and contact with the ground or other unsanitary objects during birth.

In order to meet our pledge, as a Division, as of last May, we must raise US\$1,590.91. This means each club must raise a minimum of US\$318.18 (**CI\$265.22**).

Money fundraised for The ELIMINATE Project must be submitted by December 31st in order to receive the banner patch.

How to Submit Money:

Communicate with your school's bookkeeper to know which way they accept money, whether it has to be in rolls or not.

Make sure to have an accurate recording of the amount. Then, your school's bookkeeper can write you a check.

Make sure the check is made payable to Kiwanis Children's Foundation.

Be sure to write TOT – UNICEF - FL Key Club MNT Pledge on the memo line of the check.




PROBLEM:


- New roads and urban areas are one of the main factors that cause species fragmentation and habitat loss.






