John Gray held a Car Wash on November 14 to raise funds for the Governor's Project.




Cayman Prep held a beach clean up on November 14 at Smith Cove.

If your club needs more specific advice to retain membership as the year progresses, please reach out to me! I'd love to give you individualized advice.



This year, DCON will be from April 8th - **April 11th**. This enchanting conference is usually held in Orlando at the Rosen Shingle Creek Hotel.



All of our Key Clubbers have done amazing things during their time in high school and Key Club. Now it's time for Key Club to give back to




