You are encouraged to meet over the summer, have socials and plan for the upcoming school year. Below is a short video on ways you can improve productivity.



As a Key Club District, as a family, and as a community, this tragedy hit close to home. Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School is home to a Key Club and thus we as Key Clubbers share a special bond. Many lives were forever changed that day, including those of two Key Clubbers who were victims of this terrible tragedy. Our District Administrator lost a dear family member that day, Coach Aaron Feis, who was gunned down while protecting those students he served.
