**Location:** Triple C School


**Entry Fee:** \$5

## DCON 2016

The theme of the 78<sup>th</sup> Annual Florida District Education and Leadership Conference (DCON) is **Sailing into Service!**

All Key Club members should have received the 2016 DCON letter for the parents from the Kiwanis Club of Grand Cayman. The deposit of \$100 CI was due on January 30, 2016. The other two payments of \$200 CI each are due on February 20<sup>th</sup> and March 5<sup>th</sup> respectively.

Set sail with the Florida District from **April 28<sup>th</sup>-May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016** at the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort in Orlando, Florida!

The cost of DCON is CI \$500, as the Kiwanis Club of Grand Cayman generously donates \$200 per member to reduce the cost of \$700.
