


Service Projects

The Key Clubbers enlightened her spirit by singing to her, reading the Bible and also donating money to building a house in Haiti in her honor.





As of October 26, 2014, Kiwanis-family Service Leadership Programs have raised **US\$3,170,102** in total funds.


Please remember that it is our goal for each club in the division to participate in raising money for the Eliminate Project.


Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF
